

KVC University – Learn about Reproduction and Calving your Cows!

Another education opportunity for beef and dairy producers is coming up in August. All producers and employees are welcome. The one day workshop will include presentations and videos in the morning with lunch followed by an on-farm session in the afternoon.

Learn about the reproductive cycle of a cow, when to use hormone intervention and how they work to get your cows pregnant sooner! The workshop will include practice correcting basic malpresentations during calvings, decision-making about when to call the vet, how to do an epidural, and how to freeze for dehorning.

The location is yet to be determined, but will be hosted on Wednesday August 5th in the St. Mary's or Kirkton area. The cost of the workshop is \$50/person which includes lunch. There will be a maximum of 20 participants allowed to register for this workshop. Please call the clinic to register 519-229-8911; registration closes Friday July 24th.

This is an excellent opportunity to review the reproductive cycle and use of hormones in your herd; combined with calving practice to save on vet calls and get more live calves!
